INACTIVE MEMBERSHIP

Inactive membership is an option for those members who have continued to pay dues, but are temporarily or permanently retiring from teaching snow sports due to injury, military service, pregnancy, etc.

Anyone actively involved in teaching snowsports is not eligible for inactive status and must continue to attend continuing educational clinics every 2 seasons.

Benefits of Inactive Status:

- * Maintain "good standing" status for continued membership
- * Maintain certification level
- * Exempt from attending clinic updates, although it is recommended that you continue to attend clinics to make it easier to return to active status
- * The right to attend membership functions
- * The right to purchase educational materials
- * Continue to receive national and divisional mailings
- * Lower dues

Reinstatement to Active Status

- * Pay active member dues
- * Attend a 2 day education event (if the last continuing education clinic date was within 3 seasons) or a designated Reinstatement Clinic (if last continuing education clinic date was more than 3 seasons past).

Inactive members are ALWAYS welcome at events.
